About the Program:

As part of the educational mission of ArtsConnection, we provide comprehensive internships for teens and adults seeking professional and educational experience in the area of Teen Programs/Youth Development. If you are a teen, undergraduate/graduate student, recent graduate or early career professional, you are welcome to apply for this program. We seek applicants who demonstrate an enthusiastic interest in the arts education field and a desire to learn and grow.

Internship Benefits:

ArtsConnection's Student Art Program connects young artists from NYC public schools with multiple exhibition opportunities in NYC, transforming art from a subject studied at school into a professional endeavor.

This spring, two interns will work with the Teen Programs Manager for Exhibitions to gain valuable job-readiness and administrative skills associated with all aspects of student art exhibitions and will gain a full view of a non-profit arts-in-education organization, with exposure to daily operations, program administration, and client meetings.

Interns will:

- Learn about curating and installing art through preparing for upcoming exhibitions
- Work as part of art handling team
- Participate in Teen Programs meetings
- Contribute to outreach plan for program to students, teachers and families
- Communicate with exhibiting teen artists
- Facilitate teen artists' experience at their opening receptions
- Support administration of exhibition databases
- Create online galleries using Wordpress
